


On June 15, 2020, the Rehab Optimization project will be implemented. The Rehabilitation Organizer is one of the tools being introduced, providing one location to see the Certification start and end dates for outpatient therapy patients. This also includes a count of notes completed towards a Progress Note being required.

## Rehabilitation Organizer

The Rehabilitation Organizer is accessed from a link in the toolbar.



- Patients are populated on the Rehabilitation Organizer from a selected patient list.
  - Click the **Patient List** drop-down to change the patient list.
  - Use **List Maintenance** to activate an available list or create a new list.
  - A relationship must be established with the patient in order for data to populate the list.
    - Click **Establish Relationships** to create a relationship with the patient.
  - Columns can be filtered from ascending to descending by clicking the column header.

## Rehabilitation Organizer Columns

- **Patient Column**
  - The patients name, age, and DOB display in addition to the patients MRN and FIN.
  - Click the patient's name to open the patient's chart.
- **Visit Column**
  - The LOS (Length of Stay) and the Admission Date display.
- **Location Column**
  - The name of the clinic the patient is registered to displays.

➤ **A Column**

- Allergy symbols display. Click a symbol to view allergy information.

➤ **Progress N Column**

- The number of notes that have been completed will display leading up to when a Progress Note is due.
- Once a Progress Note is completed, the counter starts all over again.

➤ **Cert End D Column**

- The Certification End date that was documented in the Certification Letter displays here.

➤ **Cert Start Column**

- The Certification Start date displays after being documented in the Certification Letter.
